

Little Thunder Girls Camp *Frequently Asked Questions*

Attention Leaders - Please read the Camp Guidelines (in the Resources section of the website) document thoroughly and see that all your leaders do the same. This will help insure a successful camp for the girls and all involved.

- **How many priesthood leaders are needed at camp?** Each stake, if coming as a stake, (or ward, if coming as a ward,) should have 2 Melchizedek Priesthood leaders in camp at all times - including spending the night. If coming as a stake, please do NOT have 2 priesthood leaders per ward. There is limited space for priesthood leaders and too many detract from the overall purpose of the camp. See the Camp Guidelines for additional information on priesthood leader guidelines.
- **Where should priesthood leaders stay at camp?** We would encourage you to have one (1) camp site designated for ALL priesthood leaders to stay in while at camp.
- **Do we need to bring disposable items for the bathrooms?** Toilet paper, paper towels, and hand soap are provided by the camp. However, shampoo, shower soap or other personal hygiene items will need to be provided by the girls/leaders if needed.
- **Do we need to carry our trash off the mountain?** Yes. NO dumpsters or garbage service exists at the camp. Please carry off all garbage and see that your camp is cleaner than when you left it. NO ONE will be cleaning up your campsites in preparation for the girls camp that follows yours. Please leave the camp as you would like to receive it.
- **Do we need to bring fresh water?** No. The camp has a spring that serves the entire camp. No additional drinking or cooking water is needed. Please do all you can to conserve water so that everyone has access to what they need.
- **Can we have camp fires?** Yes. As long as the US Forest Service has not banned fires on the mountain. Camp fires are permitted in the designated fire pits at each camp site.
- **Do we need to bring firewood?** No. The camp has adequate firewood. You will want to bring an ax or other tools to split logs and to create your own kindling to start your fires.
- **Can family members join us at camp?** No. Please do not bring younger children to girls camp - this applies to priesthood leaders and YW leaders. This detracts from the girls and the experience they are having. Pets are also not allowed at camp.
