

Camp Little Thunder

About Camp Little Thunder:

Camp Little Thunder has been created to serve the needs of Young Women, families and church groups in southern Utah. This beautiful camp is located on a spectacular tract of land in the mountains southwest of Cedar City, Utah. Elevation of the camp is approximately 9,000 feet.

The camp consists of 80 acres that host two camp grounds, Upper Camp and Lower Camp. Each camp ground has 13 campsites, restrooms, running water, fire pits, covered pavilions and amphitheatres available for use. The camp continues to undergo improvements and regular maintenance to enhance the camp experience.



Recent Improvement Projects:

- The existing spring was expanded and now has a significantly higher water flow
- 16,000 gallons of additional water storage has been added to the camp
- A well has been drilled and equipped to provide added water capacity when needed
- Four new restrooms have been built which have added a total of:
 - 4 shower stalls
 - 16 wash basins
 - 28 flush toilets on septic
- New roads connecting the upper and lower campgrounds
- New road base for all the roads within the camp
- Significant lumber and deadfall removal from the entire camp
- New/Rebuilt amphitheater in the Lower Camp
- Camp Host camp site with trailer pad and septic

Current Improvement Projects:

- New pavilion for the lower camp ground – 40' by 60' with wood burning fireplace
- Covered Cooking areas for each campsite in the Lower Camp with food preparation sink and running water
- Bunkhouses in each of the 12 lower campgrounds – no tents needed in 2010 for Lower Campground. Each bunkhouse provides:
 - Six (6) separated bunks for leaders
 - 27 bunks for young women (per campground)

Planned Improvement Projects:

- Covered Cooking areas for each campsite in the Upper Camp with food preparation sink and running water – Planned for fall 2010
- Bunkhouses in each of the 12 Upper campgrounds - no tents needed in 2011 for Upper or Lower Campground
- Hiking trail on camp property



Young Women Camp:

The primary use for the camp is for Girls Camp with camps beginning the second week of June and running through the first week of August. The camp can accommodate one stake in each of the campground areas – one stake in the upper camp and one in the lower for a total of two stakes per week at the camp.

The cost to each stake using the camp in 2010 is \$1,500. This allows each stake full access to one of the campgrounds (upper or lower) from Tuesday through Saturday of their assigned week. If a stake has an average of 10 units – this is less than \$40 per night per ward unit. A great value for the amenities and facilities provided.

We have called a full-time camp host couple to oversee all aspects of the camp while girls camp is in session. All stakes and wards must agree to abide by the camp guidelines as written. Please take the time to have your stake and ward leadership become familiar with all the camp guidelines prior to coming to camp. Guidelines can be found at www.CampLittleThunder.com.

The Little Thunder Camp is available for use by general church and family groups (such as ward youth groups, Scout troops, father/son outings, family reunions, etc.) when not in use by the Young Women.
